Healthcare Challenges

In a recent interview with Radio New Zealand, Dr. Dean Boddington, a cardiologist, shed light on the current pressures facing the healthcare system. *High-priority patients, he revealed, are waiting up to six months to be seen, while low-priority patients may not be seen at all.*

Dr. Boddington explained, “The problem is the hospital no longer has enough junior doctors, so we as specialists are now being called on to cover for them ... that for me was the point at which I thought, ‘No, I’m not doing this anymore.’” Dr. Boddington will finish his tenure at Tauranga Hospital on Friday, citing burnout as the primary reason.
